Kathryn was born and raised in Vancouver, Canada, where she received her early training at the Anna Wyman School of Dance Arts under John Ottman. Upon graduating, Kathryn joined the Ballet British Columbia mentor/apprenticeship program, where she had the opportunity to perform featured roles in works by artists such as Emily Molnar, John Alleyne, Simone Orlando, and James Gnam. She also had the opportunity to witness the creative process of artists such as Crystal Pite and the setting of works by Jiri Kylian, amongst other incredible choreographers. Following this she performed as an artist with the company in works including Carmen by Jean-Grand Maître and Peter Pan by Septime Webre.

As a freelance artist, Kathryn has worked with a wide range of companies, such as the plastic orchid factory, Judith Marcuse Projects, and Move: The Company. She also had the opportunity to work with Melanie Demers, Louise Bedard and Austin McCormick while participating in the Springboard Professional Project in Montreal. Kathryn holds a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from the University of British Columbia, focusing on injury prevention, anatomy and physiology. Kathryn has completed the Professional Dancers' Postgraduate Teaching Certificate though RAD and is trained in the Rambert Grades syllabus. Kathryn teaches both ballet and contemporary at the New Zealand School of Dance, as well being a core member of the faculty at Chilton Ballet Academy.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- MUSIC This year we will be using Dance App NZ to upload the music. Please ensure you bring back up music on a USB stick or a phone. (as a single track for each dance) Music will need to be uploaded by July 1st.
- 2. Under 12 years, dances should be no longer than TWO and a HALF minutes; and no longer than THREE minutes for dancers 12 years and over. Teams up to FOUR and a HALF minutes.
- 3. NOVICE applies to a competitor who has not won first place in any Novice, Restricted or Open class of that genre, entered at this or any other competition. If a class in any competition is not labelled as Novice or Restricted then it counts as Open. Students cannot go back into Novice when moving up an age group. A 'Novice' competitor may choose to dance in the open or the novice but not both. Once a competitor has won a novice they are only eligible to enter the open.
- 4. Championship Classes are only eligible to any competitor who has won an **Open Classical or Open Jazz** Class in any competition (You may repeat your solo). You must compete in at least TWO other classes relevant to that Championship Class at these competitions, ie Classical Solo compulsory, then 2 other classes (marked **) from the Classical Section. These **dances (with the exception of Classical Pointe) cannot be danced in the Championship. For Modern Jazz, the MJ Solo is compulsory, as well as 2 other classes from the Modern Jazz Section (marked**).
- 5. A class may amalgamate if less than 3 entries received. The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split classes where necessary. The committee also reserves the right to split large classes into smaller classes based on age.
- 6. Duos and Pas de Deux may be danced with different partners. A dancer may only dance twice in a duo/trio class but it must be with a different partner.
- 7. Champion of Champions nominees will be selected by the adjudicator. Up to 10 nominees may be selected.
- 8. Boys Classical Dance Class 110 must be a different dance to that in Open or Novice Classical Section, but can repeat in the Championship if eligible.

Boys Modern Any Dance Under 12 Class 208 must be a different dance to any dance in Open or Novice M/J Section but can be repeated in the Championship if eligible.

- 9. Senior **Variation** competitors must enter both Section A & Section B to be eligible for the overall placing. 14 year olds may choose to enter in either Senior or Junior Variation Class but not both.
- 10. Only Ballet &/or Modern Jazz <u>No Tap</u> to be danced in any class in these competitions.
- 11. Class 304 and 304a Student Choreography Class must be presented as a student's own original work.
- 12. Original Choreography means not a Variation, or copied from another source such as YouTube.
- 13. Class 301 is for **Under 7 dancers.** (An opportunity for the little ones to dance any appropriate Solo dance from the Ballet/Modern Jazz syllabus)
- 14. Impromptu Dress Code must be adhered to; otherwise competitor may be disqualified. Plain colour, (minimal decorations or lace at the discretion of officials) no jewellery or hair accessories. Hair in bun or tied up as appropriate please read the Impromptu class carefully.
- 15. Classical Barefoot Classes please note no footwear whatsoever to be worn in Classical Barefoot classes.
- 16. The only classes where a dance may be repeated are Under 7, PACANZ nominations and Championships.
- 17. The age of the competitor is the age they are on the start date of the competition.
- 18. Please read the General Conditions on the website before entering this competition.

NATIONAL YOUNG PERFORMER AWARDS 2024 CRITERIA FOR BALLET

A. Performers will be 15 and under 21 years as at 1st of October 2024.

B. Each performer will compete in three classes during the preliminary round to showcase their ability

2. Solo Variation from any recognised classical repertoire which MAY or MAY not be from the list in B.1. The selection, however, **MUST** show a **clear contrast** in style to the variation selected in section B.1.

3. All performers will participate in a Technical Class conducted by or for the Adjudicators. No audience observation will be permitted. The Technical Class will be taken into consideration in determining the semi-finalists.

C. There will be a semi-final of up to twelve performers who will repeat either B. 1 or B. 2 at the discretion of the adjudicators. The number of semi-finalists is determined as per the NYPA rules 7.1-7.2. Competitors will be chosen based on their marks in the Preliminary round(s).

D. For the Final Award Concert six performers will be recalled, and shall repeat the item not performed at the semi final.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

Only enter the Nomination class if you are seeking a Nomination **AND** are committed to attending and competing at the National Young Performer Awards in Palmerston North 25-27 Oct 2024.

SOCIETY NOMINATION

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, **may nominate up to two competitors**, who shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a performance as outlined in A-D.

The adjudicator will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Finals.

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

• A demonstration of adequate preparation

• An authority of performance

• A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group.

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has **NOT** been reached by any competitor, then **NO** nomination will be made.

The Nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. **\$75 inc gst per Nominee**

Each Nominee is responsible for paying the rest of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. **\$225.00 incl gst**



NATIONAL YOUNG PERFORMER AWARDS 2024 CRITERIA FOR TROUPES

A. Competitors will be under 21 years as at 1st of October 2024. Competitors may compete in ONE nominated Troupe only. The ONLY exception is when they perform in their Studio Troupe and for their Primary School/High School/Educational Institution. In order to represent a Studio or School, the Dancer MUST be a registered (fee paying) Student of the Organisation.
B. Each Troupe will be nominated at a Member Society Competition by performing in any dance genre pertinent to the Competition they enter. This competition is for amateur troupes only and

is not open to professionals*.

C. There will be a maximum time limit of 4 1/2 minutes, taken from the beginning to the conclusion of the music.

D. Troupes who gain nomination must be able to attend the National Young Performer Competition which will be held in Palmerston North. Compulsory Registration/Orientation will be on Thursday 24th October and the Competition will be on Friday 25th October 2024.

E. A Final will be held on the afternoon/evening of Friday 24th October, with up to 18 Troupes recalled to perform. The number of Troupes in the Final may change, at the discretion of the Adjudicator(s)

F. It MAY be possible for the top 3 Troupes to perform at the Soloist Final Award Concert on the evening of Sunday 27th October 2024.

G. Costumes, choreography & music should be appropriate to the age of both the competitors and suitable for a family audience.

ADDITIONAL RULES

A. Once a Troupe Item has received a Nomination, it is no longer eligible to enter another Nomination class. The Dancers in the Nominated Troupe cannot perform in an additional Troupe to assist in gaining a Nomination. The Studio name, the Item name and the genre of the nominated item will be published on the PACANZ website as soon as PACANZ is notified by the nominating Society.

B. The Nominating Troupe will be required to complete the entire Entry process, via the APP, within 14 days of receiving a Nomination. The Entry process will include uploading a Video file of the Nominated Troupe item. Video footage taken at the Competition where the Nomination was awarded would be most appropriate.

C. The Item receiving a Nomination and submitted in the Video file following nomination, will be the same Item when it is performed at the National Young Performer Awards on 25th October 2024. Minor alterations are allowed in choreography and costuming. Dancer numbers and/or actual dancers, can only be altered on receipt of a Medical certificate OR with the PACANZ Office sign off on extenuating or special circumstances. These alterations to Dancer numbers and/or actual dancers, may affect either the Item at the time of Nomination AND/OR the Item being presented at the NYPA. If clarity is required in regards to any changes, please contact the PACANZ Office PRIOR to making the changes.

D. Troupe nominations are subject to challenge and a Troupe risks disqualifying themselves, if the above criteria are not adhered to.NB. The CLOSING DATES will be relative to the date of Nomination. Troupe members' names and ages, the Item name and genre & entry fee will need to be submitted in the Official APP Entry by the closing date. The Video file will also need to be uploaded as part of the Entry process.

Nominees in the Troupe section are required to upload a performance copy of their music in MP3 format when submitting their entry, and a list of the titles and composer and/or artists for each piece. They must bring the same music on USB to registration. SOCIETY NOMINATION

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate TWO Troupes**, who shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a performance at the Member Society Competition.

The adjudicator will determine that the Troupe has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Troupe Finals.

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

A demonstration of adequate preparation

• An authority of performance

• A performance with a level of expertise commensurate with a national final competition. If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any Troupe, then NO nomination will be made.

The nominated Troupe is responsible for paying the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$300.00 incl gst, for up to 10 Troupe dancers, plus \$10 inc gst for each and every additional dancer.

* A professional is someone whose primary employment is being paid to perform or work in the performing arts. For the present purposes, being a student constitutes "primary employment" and therefore is not seen as a Professional. For the Student who receives payment for participation, either teaching or performing, this should not impose professional status on a person if it is by way only of an occasional bonus or benefit rather than their principal means of earning a livelihood.

** As some Societies split their dance genres and run large Competitions with different Judges and/or at different times of the year, they will be able to nominate more than one Troupe to represent their Society.

** If a Society has 10 or more Troupes that enter and compete for a Troupe Nomination, then they are entitled to offer an additional Nomination. This applies to every multiple of 10 Troupes that enter and compete for a Troupe Nomination. Therefore –

1-9 Troupes = 2 Nominations

10 Troupes = 1 additional Nomination

20 Troupes = 2 additional Nominations

30 Troupes = 3 additional Nominations

40 Troupes = 4 additional Nominations
