## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. This competition is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of An Coimisiunn le Rinci Gaelacha and the Traditional Irish Dancing Association (TIDANZ)
2. Dancers must be registered with CLRG to be eligible to enter this competition.
3. The official entry form provided must be used for dancer/school entry and received from teachers. Payment made be made directly to the account 03 1707 0037805 006 with dancer's name as reference.
4. It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the entry submitted is correct.
5. The age of the competitor shall be taken as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024. Where a competitor's birth date falls on 1<sup>st</sup> January they shall, for the purpose of the competition, be regarded as under the age attained on that date.
6. Age groups will be determined and split when all entries are received.
7. Dancers, where eligible can dance in their BASE grade level and one above. Grades for dancers are determined by the TIDA of NZ Grading Syllabus.

## **CANCELLATION:**

If this competition has to be cancelled any entry fees paid will be returned minus the administration fee (\$25) which will be kept to cover costs incurred for the event.
